### **WELCOME FROM THE DIRECTORS**

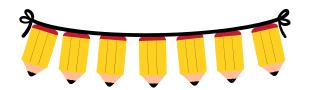

# WHAT TO EXPECT: THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

- Arrival Enter through the main front door entrance and accompany your child to his/her classroom.
   Please keep your little one close to you while walking in the parking lot and inside the building.
   Classroom doors open at 8:55 am.
- Dismissal Parents/authorized persons will use the car rider line for pick-up at the south entrance.
   Dismissal will start about ten minutes before end time to help keep traffic moving smoothly (e.g. 11:20am, 12:20pm, 2:50pm).
- **Tag System** We use a color-coded, numbered tag system to dismiss students. Students will get one tag that will go on their backpacks and two matching rear-view mirror tags for drivers who pick up the student. Please have the tag displayed before entering the parking lot.

• Lunch - Full-day students and those attending Enrichment hour (11:30am-12:30pm) need to bring a packed lunch with an ice pack or thermos and a filled water bottle. Please make sure water bottles and lunchboxes are labeled with your child's name.
