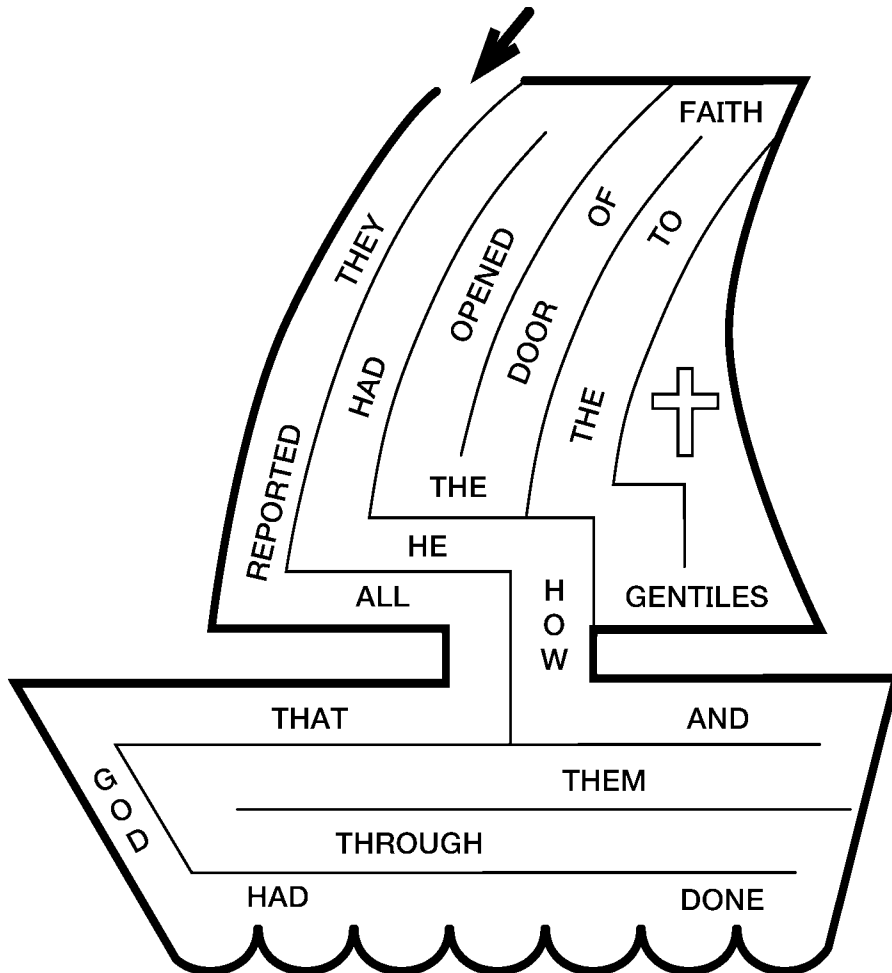




Paul and Barnabas completed the work they had been sent out to accomplish.

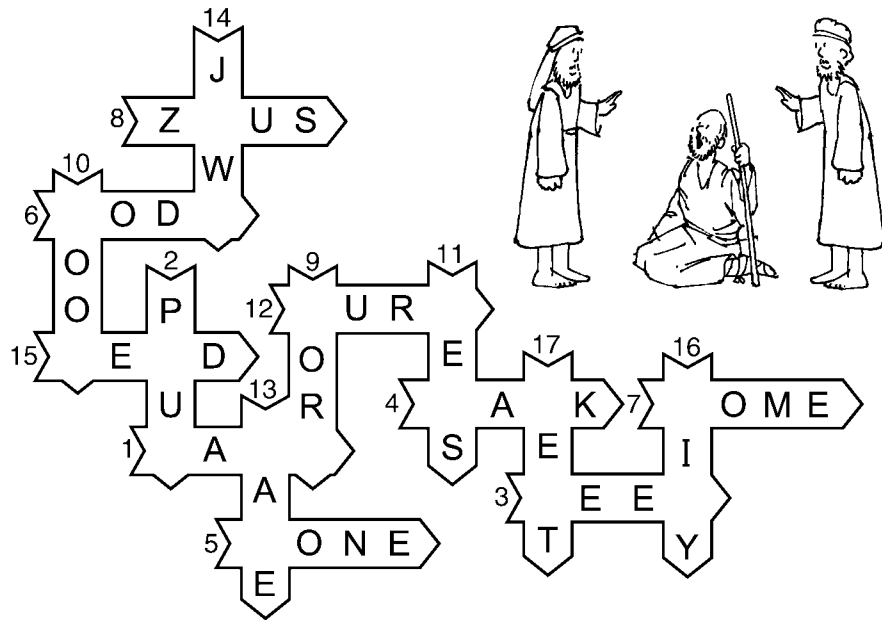
